Students in 6th, 7th and 8th grade will participate in the South Carolina College and Career READY Assessments (SC READY), which is comprised of the ELA writing and reading tests and the mathematics test. All 6th grade students will also be taking the SC READY science test. PSAT NMSQT  8th graders will have the opportunity to participate in the SC Junior Scholars Program by taking the PSAT NMSQT. Testing information, permission forms, and payment instructions will be sent home with 8th grade students.
