<b>MAP</b>	<p>All students participate in MAP Growth testing three times during the school year. MAP Growth is a computer-adaptive test meaning every student gets a unique set of test questions based on responses to previous questions. MAP Growth is used as a Benchmark to determine what students know and how they are growing academically.</p>	<p><b>Fall:</b> ELA August 25-29 Math September 2-5</p> <p><b>Winter:</b> ELA December 1-5 Math December 8-12</p> <p><b>Spring:</b> ELA April 13-17 Math April 20-24</p>

<b>SC Ready</b>	<p>Students in 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade will participate in the South Carolina College and Career READY Assessments (SC READY), which is comprised of the ELA writing and reading tests and the mathematics test. All 6<sup>th</sup> grade students will also be taking the SC READY science test. <b>PSAT NMSQT</b>	<p>8<sup>th</sup> graders will have the opportunity to participate in the SC Junior Scholars Program by taking the PSAT NMSQT. Testing information, permission forms, and payment instructions will be sent home with 8<sup>th</sup> grade students.
